But, once we're gathered, there is still much to do. In fact, there are things to be done even before we gather. Perhaps you would consider enriching our worship life together by helping out in one of our essential lay roles.

We are in urgent need of people to take on some of these roles:

Sidesperson-Greeter (Welcoming people, taking up the offering...)

Reader (Read from scripture during the service)

Intercessor (Lead us in prayer using the printed words in the liturgy)

Communion Administrator (Administer the chalice – at Communion)

Anointer / Offering prayer for healing (Offer short prayer and anointing anyone who comes up for healing prayer in our 3rd Sunday service)

Chancel Guild (Be part of the team that prepares the vessels, hangings, polishes brass and silver, arranges flowers ...)

Server/Crucifer (Assist the clergy at the altar, carry the cross in procession ...)

Choir (Help lead the congregation in song and prepare the occasional special music to deepen our worship experience)

Training is available for all of these roles. Please speak to Fr. Mike if you would like to help our worship life flourish in any of these ways.
